## **The OSCE in the migration and refugee crisis**

What challenges does the OSCE and Western Balkans states face in their response to the migration crisis? What is the Austrian approach in this area, considering that it assumes the OSCE Chairmanship-in-Office in 2017? These questions and others will be discussed. Also, a short presentation of a study carried under the auspices of the Southeast Europe Association (SOG) in the framework of the German OSCE Chairmanship in Office 2016 will be given.
