The event is a continuation of the third Western Balkans Reflection Forum at the Austrian Permanent Representation on 4 July 2018. The Western Balkans Reflection Forum is a Europe-wide think tank and dialogue initiative launched by the Austro-French Centre for Rapprochement in Europe (ÖFZ), the Centre international de formation européenne (CIFE), the German Institute for International and Security Affairs (SWP), the Istituto Affari Internazionali (IAI) and the Institut français des relations internationales (Ifri) in 2014.

Matteo Bonomi of the Istituto Affari Internazionali (IAI) will give a keynote speech, presenting a policy paper on the outcome of the last reflection forum. The paper takes stock of recent developments six months after the Sofia Summit and assesses the challenges the current approach to enlargement is facing, such as economic and demographic development in the region, and the implications of Brexit for the Western Balkans.

This will be followed by a panel debate with Rainer Münz, Adviser on Migration and Demography to the European Political Strategy Centre (EPSC), Brussels, Simonida Kacarska, Director of the European Policy Institute (EPI), Skopje, Adnan Ćerimagić, Analyst at the European Stability Initiative (ESI), Sarajevo, and Stefan Lehne, Visiting Scholar at Carnegie Europe, Brussels.

The discussion will be moderated by Sabina Lange from the European Institute of Public Administration (EIPA).

The event will be followed by a cocktail reception.
